When we nurture the Earth's roots, we ensure that life will continue to grow strong, resilient, and grounded, weathering every storm with wisdom and grace.

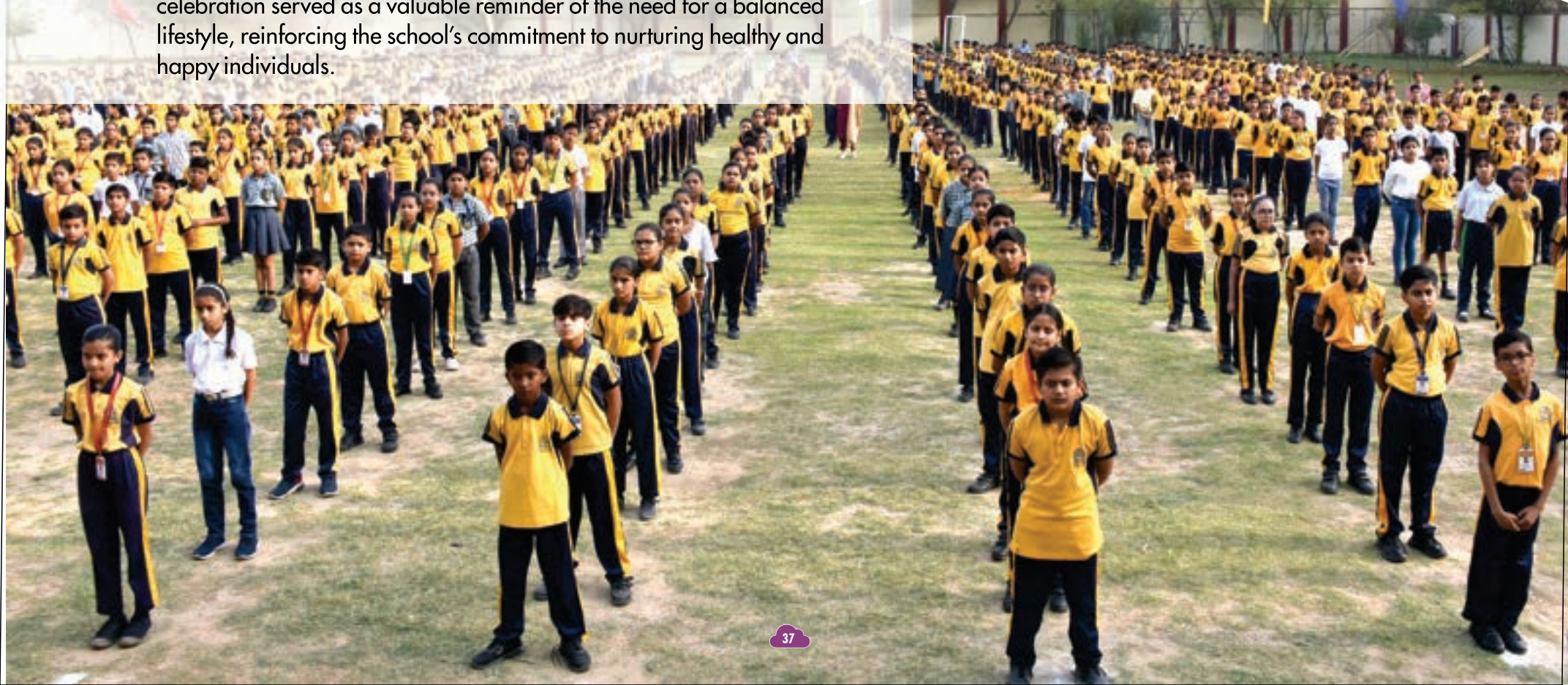


# Celebration
